What is it?

Middlesex East County Rangers is a flexible unit bringing together participants from across the county to network, build friendships and work on the new Girlguiding Programme.

What happens at meetings?

Every meeting will be different, some will have a badge theme and some will be events like ME Time or Gilwell 24. Badge themes are advertised in advance, and in most cases badges will be completed and awarded within the meeting.

Each meeting has quiet time to ask questions, sign-off qualifications and hang out. County Rangers also support 14-18s working towards qualifications in Girlguiding.

We're not a traditional unit in that we don't have a set meeting place, time or day. We plan to meet 4-8 times a year with a mixture of days and residentials. You don't have to attend all meetings, just come to the ones that interest you, or when you're available.

For Young Leaders without a Ranger unit this provides space to interact with their peers and work towards the Ranger Gold Award.

For those already members of Ranger units the County unit is not intended as a replacement. It allows a great space to network, learn about wider opportunities available and supplement the programme activities and fun they experience.

Who is it for?

All 14-18s, including older Guides, Rangers and Young Leaders. You can attend with your Ranger unit, with your Guiding friends, or on your own.

Information ... for Members

If you are a Young Leader this is your opportunity to work on the Ranger Programme, the same as if you were in a Ranger unit.

If you're already a Ranger you can gain Skills Builders, build up your UMAs and quickly get your Theme Awards and then on to your Ranger Gold.

All of this is done in an exclusively 14-18 setting, and most importantly of all you'll be able to have fun - great food, wide games, movie marathons and campfires are regular fixtures.
