Rangers are encouraged to make their own way to Gilwell Park, a shuttle bus is provided from and to Chingford Station, which is a few minutes from Walthamstow Central on the Victoria Line. The roads can be very busy, especially for Sunday pick ups, please get together and share lifts.

The nature of Gilwell24 is to stay awake for 24 hours from 09:00 Saturday to 09:00 Sunday, and activities run all night. Limited tents will be provided for some down time, those who wish to sleep should bring a sleeping bag & roll mat.
