First Response Refresher

To attend a First Response Refresher, you must first have attended a Girlguiding Full First Response Course (required for ALQ), this lasts for 3 years. Within 3 years and 6 months grace you must attend a refresher for it to remain valid.

If you don't renew in that time you will need to re do a Full First Response Course.
